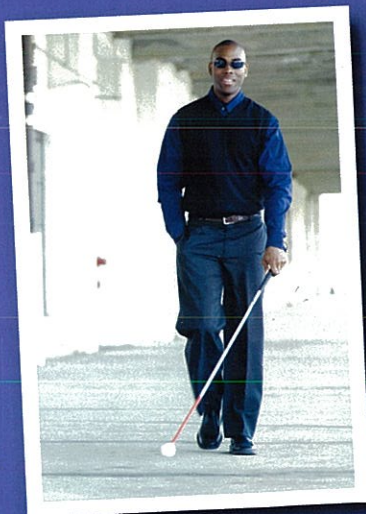
- The ADRC targets older adults and persons with disabilities with the goal of empowering individuals to make informed choices about services.

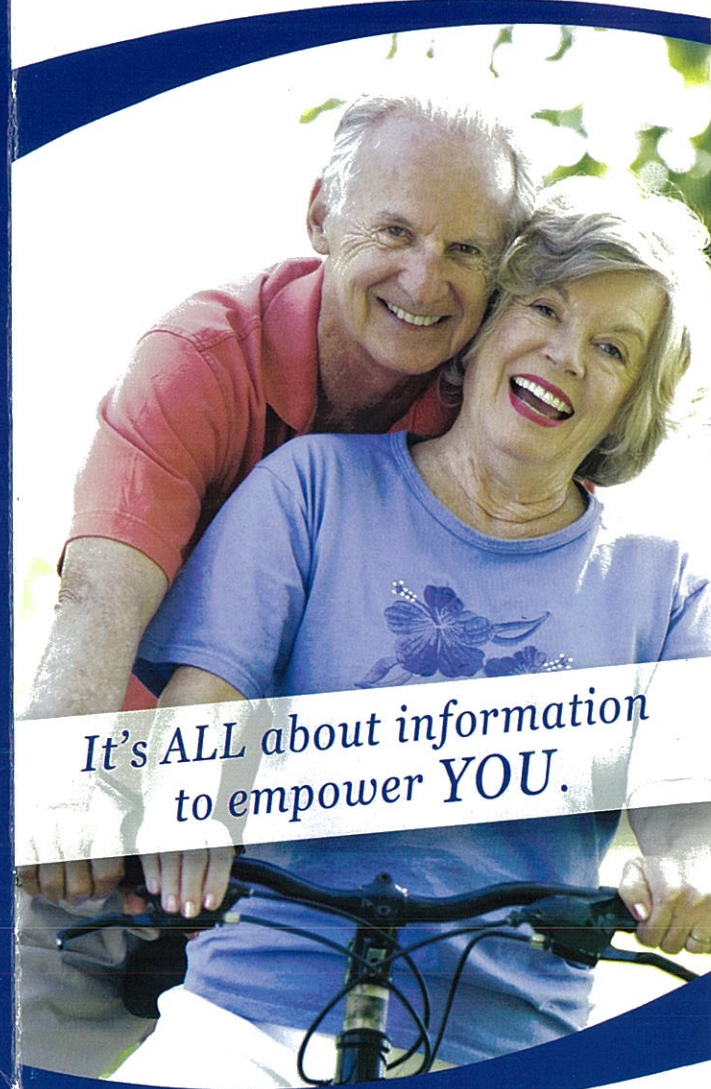
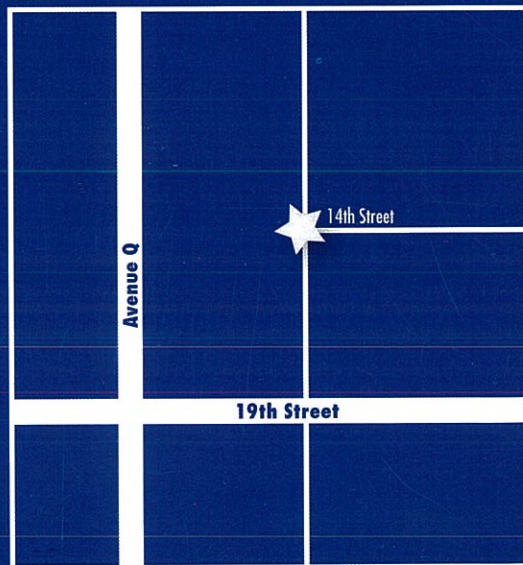
